How to Use This Book

Get the most out of every page

This volume is organized into twenty-two chapters, sequenced so that each chapter naturally builds the depth a hiring panel will probe. The progression — fundamentals, modules, configuration, process flow, integration, support, migration, project, senior-level, behavioral, version-specific — mirrors the real arc of an end-to-end Infor LN Logistics interview cycle.

Three reading patterns are recommended:

FOR THE 7-DAY SPRINT

Days 1–2: Chapters 1–6 (foundations + Procurement, Sales, Inventory, Warehousing). Day 3: Chapters 7–9 (lot/serial, freight, planning). Day 4: Chapters 10–12 (master planning, EDI/ION, ICT). Day 5: Chapters 13–16 (methodology, configuration, process, support). Day 6: Chapters 17–19 (migration, project, senior). Day 7: Chapters 20–22 (behavioral, version-specific, cheat sheet).

FOR THE 21-DAY DEEP-DIVE

One chapter per day, with a 30-minute mock interview at the end of each day where a friend asks the questions and you answer aloud. Re-read after day 14, focusing only on the questions you stumbled on the first time.

FOR THE SAME-DAY EMERGENCY

Chapter 22 (Cheat Sheet), Chapter 19 (Senior-level patterns), and the version-specific section in Chapter 21. Skim talking points, not whole answers.

Every question is annotated with one or more *tags* indicating where it most often surfaces — Implementation, Setup, Process, Support, Migration, Project or Senior. Treat these as a heat-map for your own weakness areas.
